Summary:

For the 2400 rounds for 4 months example, the cost for the ammunition would be about including a gas estimate.

\$1,320.00

The cost for a progressive press (square deal B either new with the 4 month wait) would be \$379.95 plus tax S/H

If the cost for a used Square Deal B \$650.00 about \$271 dollars more.
